### Women's Refuge

We have been in contact with an organisation  
which runs a Women's Refuge and have  
offered to supply morse bags containing practical  
essentials for women and children fleeing domestic  
violence.

We would need folk to help make morse bags and  
a collection of things to go in the bags. Ideally we  
would have 3 types of bags - adults, school age  
and and pre-school. They would contain things like  
toothbrush (with case) , toothpaste, flannel, hand-  
towel, wipes, deodorant, soap/bodywash/shower gel,  
shampoo & conditioner and hairbrush/combs.  
Moisturisers for adults, colouring books and felts for  
children , sweets (like Haribo - they will last, etc  
would not go amiss either! Please see Ian if you want  
more information. Someone has also suggested  
baby/make-up wipes and fluffy socks!!
